At A Glance:

US markets continued to fall with corn leading the way, higher global feed grain competition a key driver. Wheat done well to only fall 10c/bu as it was caught up in the selling. Global production is a record for wheat this year and export sales continue to be very competitive, the US sighting a stronger dollar and lower demand for US wheat as a major reason for recent declines in US wheat futures. Local markets faded late Friday with durum off its \$527/t high for DR1 on the track, closing closer to \$517 for Gunnedah south markets. Malt barley was also slightly lower with a late trade of \$340 for GA1 on the track suggesting a softer market today but these guys are renowned for playing ducks and drakes. Traders expect to see a lot of grain get priced up over the next two weeks and will compete for it.

Weather:

NE winds will swing around to the NW during the beginning of the week creating much needed hot / dry conditions. There is a slight chance of a thunderstorm mid week but this looks unlikely, by Friday a deep low over SA may trigger storms across NSW but conditions are expected to clear again by the weekend.
