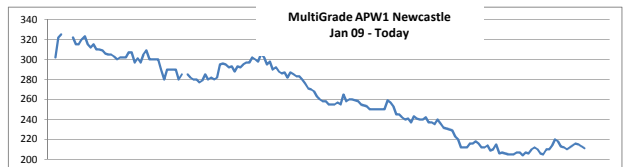

Comments
 Local markets held on well Friday with pulses flat and feed grains and lower grades only fractionally lower or in the case of barley stronger. Grower selling remains light with most growers electing to withdraw from the market as prices drift lower. There has been little wheat sold with most producers looking to price canola before the market slipped Friday. Looking overseas for direction on canola values we see further losses in ICE futures and CBOT beans. Canola is under continued pressure from the new phytosanitary restraints from China, nil blackleg requirements will keep prices softer in the short term. Higher than expected jobless rates in the US (10.2%) saw crude lower which dragged grains with it. Harvest pressure also picked up in the corn and beans market with some fine weather finally seeing an increase in pace. Gold was also stronger on the back of the weak economic data out of the US, topping \$1100 for the first time. On the export front we continue to see ocean freight rates pushed higher by strong demand for bulk vessels to China, this is having a knock on effect through the box trade and we may see some premiums for products like DR1 and milling wheat in the near term. Look for weaker prices today ahead of a USDA report this week.

Weather
 Storms will contract into Qld during the first half of the week. Temperatures are expected to climb into the mid 30s by Wednesday leading to good harvest weather this week. NE winds should tend more NW as the week progresses. Ten day model shows storms concentrated around SE Qld.
