**Comments**

Indian chickpea futures made a slight recovery over the weekend, at one point it looked like a \$10 - \$20 slip was on the cards today but a rally in futures should see local prices stabilise. Week on week US wheat futures were all lower with the higher protein markets falling the most, CBOT nearby wheat was off 17.5c/bu (roughly \$7.00/tonne) while the KCBT and MGEX were off 18.75c and 20.5c respectively. Corn put on 15.5c/bu for the week after an intense snow storm across the mid west of the US will make it more difficult to harvest the last 10% of corn still standing in the fields. ICE canola futures were relatively unchanged for the week. On the local front the market was generally softer for wheat with falls of between \$3.00 and \$6.00 per tonne across the board, canola closed \$5.00 off its high but still up \$3.00 week on week. Canola continues to defy global expectations, higher Canadian production and slowing demand should all point to a softer market but prices across the world continue to climb on fund buying. Durum, hands up who has 1000t of durum stored, oh, that many of you. Sellers are beginning to creep into the market as buyers and consumers show nothing but a lack of interest in using price to flush grain onto a market that well lets be honest, doesn't really appear to want to own durum just at the moment, DR1 continues to work into the feed complex at \$205 - \$210 XFLPP and that is likely to be its fate.

**Weather**

Cloud over NSW and S Qld is expected to create a few storms north of the border today, the cloud is associated with a low over the corner country, this low is expected to dissipate through the day before re-emerging later in the week in central Australia the trough line associated with this low cell is expected to produce storms across the region late Thursday and possibly Friday.
