At A Glance:

Headers were back in fields west on Moree this morning with nothing but dissatisfaction ahead of them. A line from the border passing through Bullarah and Burren Junction has seen mostly shot and sprung wheat present in the fields. To add insult to injury this is the same grain that had previously been grading HPS1, high protein high screenings, now it's meeting AH9 specs, 68TW but no minimum falling number limit and over 11.5% protein. Initial reports off the Liverpool Plains are variable, some bread wheat has done it pretty tough but with visible signs of sprouting and black point whilst other fields only a week less matures show no visible signs of weather damage apart from a slight darkening of the crease. I'm keen to hear back from you in regards to how your crop fared.

Weather:

Conditions should gradually warm through the week before more storms on Friday. Weather models are conflicting greatly on location of the storms but the most reliable models appear to be centring the activity in SW / SE Qld with falls also likely around NNSW but of less intensity of the ones in the north, fingers crossed
