Afternoon Comments

Sorghum was a mixed bag today, the old crop market is dead with track business changing hands at \$232 less rail, ex farm off the Liverpool Plains was even worse with \$200 about the peak of it. The demand is simply not there at present, bigger traditional sorghum consumers like Bartters are simply using wheat in their ration at the moment and Bartters are not the only ones doing this. New crop sorghum traded briefly at \$250 Newcastle less rail this afternoon, tonnage was limited. This seems to be the trend at the moment so if you would like to get a little new crop business done at \$250 let me know and I'll make sure you get on the list for netx time around. Old crop 70-10 wheat traded at \$210 ex farm Liverpool plains, a slight premium over sorghum but at least it appears to have a little higher demand than old crop sorghum ex farm. Both corn and wheat futures on the Chicago e session are fractionally lower while the dollar remains close to where it opened the days trading. ASX milling wheat is currently untraded with a bid offer of \$266 / \$270 for the Jan 12 contract.
