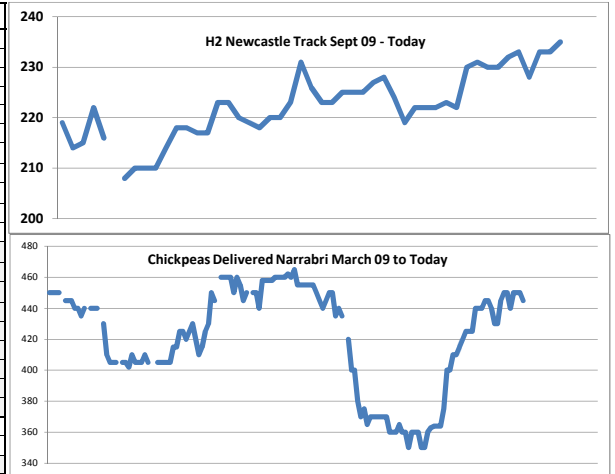

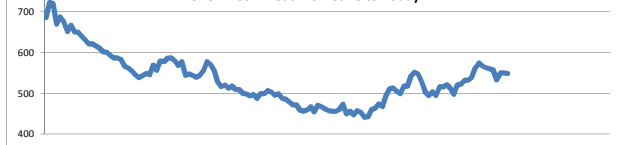
Comments

Currency continues to swing wildly with the AUD slipping into the 90s yesterday only to recover back into the high 91s this morning. The spill over from Dubai World is expected to be far reaching but analyst are still filtering through who is likely to be most effected by one of the biggest defaults we have seen in a while. Yesterday the U.A.E central bank announced a facility that basically underwrites the loans of Dubai World so things may not be as dire as first expected late last week. Why, why didn't palm tree shaped man made islands covered in 200sq mansions take off, who knows. Back to reality.....sigh.... in the US markets were thin as most traders elected to make a long weekend of the shortened week. Volume saw markets react a little more than expected but fundamental news ensured thing remained fairly flat by the close. Paris futures reflected the US moves and closed either side of flat in both milling wheat and rapeseed. Local markets saw increased grower selling on Friday with end of month today. December should see increased selling as farmers defer income into the J/F/M quarter. The week ahead looks likely to be more of the same but dryer. Analyst are expected Dec CBOT wheat to slip a little this week as deliveries are expected to be high, this may see some pressure on our local prices but to date the basis has been able to absorb smaller moves. NAB carve 2mt of our wheat crop.

Weather

Temperatures should remain a little milder for the first half of the week before climbing back into the mid to high 30s by the weekend. The week ahead looks unlikely to offer up and rain with showers remaining to our SE and predominately coastal. The ten day shows little improvement with no rain expected through to mid December.
